A 26-year-old North Sacramento man was shot to death Friday night following an altercation in a bar at 12th St. Homicide detectives said Robert E. Lee, 2720 Rose Ave., died after being shot once in the chest at 7:30 p.m. in PNC's Police. They said four persons were in the bar at the time of the shooting.

Officers said the shooting occurred when Lee began arguing with a bartender and the suspect intervened. They said after the fatal shot was fired the suspect jumped in a car with another man and drove away.
